PERFORMING ACTIVITIES

Concert Series

The SBMC presents a highly acclaimed community concert series: twice-monthly Saturday Afternoon Concerts from October to June at 3 p.m. Programs are held in downtown venues, including Faulkner Gallery of the Santa Barbara Public Library, First United Methodist Church, and Trinity Episcopal Church. Concerts feature SBMC members and invited guests, with many performers being of professional reputation and some of international renown. Programs highlight both traditional and contemporary repertoire, performed by instrumental and vocal soloists and chamber ensembles.

Each season's final two concerts showcase winners of the annual SBMC Scholarship Awards. Additionally, concerts commemorating composer anniversaries, notable SBMC members, or other special events are scheduled as appropriate.

SBMC concerts are open to the public, admission is free, and venues are wheelchair accessible. Concert information is available on the SBMC website, in monthly SBMC newsletters, local newspapers, online calendars, and on radio.

Community Outreach

SBMC members regularly present solo and chamber music performances at area retirement communities. These programs are an important extension of our commitment to bring great music into the community, especially to individuals who are unable to attend our regular concerts.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Through the generosity of our donors, the SBMC awards scholarships to talented young performers who are residents of Santa Barbara County. Scholarship winners are selected through annual competitions, and application announcements are made in January for auditions to be scheduled for late March or early April. Application Forms and Guidelines are posted on the SBMC website and are distributed to area music teachers and college/university music departments.

GOVERNANCE

The SBMC is governed by a Board of Directors that meets monthly during the concert season and as needed during the summer months. Officers are nominated by the Board of Directors and elected for a two-year term by the membership at the annual meeting, held at the final non-scholarship concert of the season.

SBMC committees include the following: Concert, Concert Support, Financial, Internet, Membership/ Development, Scholarship, and Special Events/ Hospitality. Participation in committees, including as chair, is open to the membership at large.
